

Tiny "The Guernsey Star"

Thomas Coplestone = Elizabeth Mitchell, Stoke Damerel 1775 Baker

Had "The Hon. Mrs. Groom" at Kensington 1811. (+ siblings)

Thomas Mitchell = Sarah (Robert?) Edmonston at Walton, Suffolk, aged 17, widow, 24.2.1804 b. 1787-8

Master R.N. 1806, Dismissed the Service 1810 for neglect of duty and disobedience. Reinstated 1812. Master's Logs in his hand at several PRO, Kew.

St. Geo. the Martyr, Southwark 13.3.1825

George Horatio = Maria Barker (1) d. W. Kerby 1857 Jane Cummings, wid. L'pool. w. Kerby 1860 (2)

Laid "wife + 2 ch." in 1812.

Joseph George Thompson 28.11.1825 Guernsey b. 'Middx. London' 1805 Joiner RN + CG b. 1830's. Elizabeth Wylie of Wilby Liskeard 6.2.1851 Guernsey

Geo. Wm. Thos. 12.3.1852 Guernsey Elizabeth 1853 Plymouth Thomas Mitchell 1861 Liverpool John Alfred 1856 Liverpool William John Stonemason Sec. 1866 Liverpool = Elizabeth Hughes John, butcher b. 1907 = Ada Elizabeth Barnard Stephen = Margaret Andrew Laura
