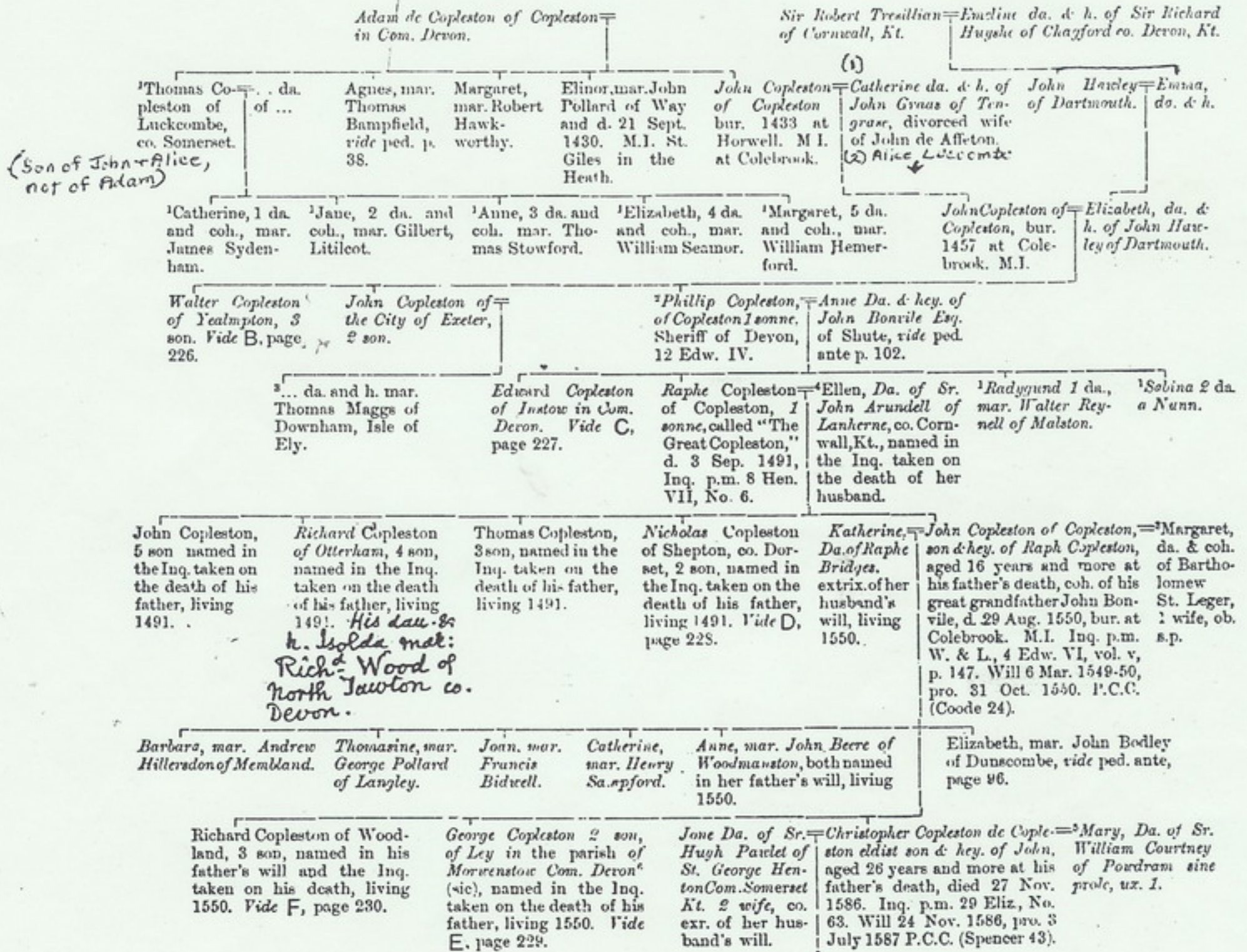


## COPELSTON OF COPELSTON.
